

# Cantre Mobility Website Accessibility Information

Any device or software capable of displaying Web content can access information from this website, including text-only browsers, audio browsers, screen-reading and screen magnification software. A small number of site visitors using older and non-standards-compliant browsers will notice a less visually rich site design. While all browsers will display all content, the use of these older browsers may affect how this content appears visually on the page.

## Adjusting your text size

The text size used on this site can be configured within your browser. This feature may be useful if you are visually impaired or have a large or small monitor.

Your browser's default text size should look good, however, if the setting has been changed, text may appear too large or too small

## Style Sheets

This site incorporates Cascading Style Sheets, which enabled users to customise these pages to suit their own needs using their own styles. The site text and background colours can all be overridden with your own preferences, catering for your needs. This is usually possible in the browser option or accessibility settings but please consult your software help option for any information regarding this.

## Access Keys

A feature used to improve ease of navigation is the use of Access Keys. These are shortcut keys used to gain instant access to important or common parts of the site. The current list of Access Keys on the site is:

Letter - **E** - takes you to the VAT Exemption Page.

Letter - **F** - takes you to the Order Paper Catalogue Page.

Letter - **G** - takes you to the How to Order Offline Page.

Letter - **H** - takes you to the About Us Page.

Letter - **I** - takes you to the Support Services Page.

Letter - **J** - takes you to our links.

To use the Access Keys on your system, please follow these steps as they vary slightly across browsers and operating systems:

- In Internet Explorer 6 on PC, use **Alt** plus the **Access Key** then Enter.
- In Netscape 6 on PC, use **Alt** plus **Access Key** to activate the shortcut.
- In Netscape 6 or Internet Explorer 5 on Mac, use **Ctrl** plus **Access Key**.

## **Tabbing**

To move from link to link, the Tab key can be used to navigate around the site without the need for a mouse. For additional ease of use, a logical tab index system has been included in the website so priority links such as the search field text entry are only a few tab key presses away.
